

**GETTING IT RIGHT IN FIFE GROUP**  
(Previously Quality Improvement Working Group)

**09 December 2008**

Key points raised at this meeting were as follows:

1. **Child Protection Inspection** - Brief information shared on verbal feedback stage post inspection and agreement that fuller discussion on implications and recommendations from inspection will be required across strategic groups.
2. **Joint Action Teams** - Dave Wright provided information on process of self evaluation being undertaken by JAT. Discussion on membership of groups, differences in contribution and effectiveness across Fife, need to evaluate outcomes based on principles of self-evaluation.
3. **Parenting Strategy** - Information previously circulated on current parenting programmes being delivered across range of providers. Information had been requested from the Voluntary Sector but response had been patchy.

Agreement that a focused group would be set up to consider more fully strategy and links with Early Years Strategy – Lynn Gillies (Barnardo’s Family Matters) to attend in first instance.

4. **Monitoring of Children’s Service Plan outcomes** - Fiona Power circulated papers and information added.
5. **Getting It Right in Fife pack** – Agreement that series of presentations to take place across departments and agencies i.e. Education, JAT, Health.
