

REMIT OF GLENROTHES AND NORTH EAST FIFE LOCAL MENTAL HEALTH PARTNERSHIP

Purpose

The Local Mental Health Partnership (LMHP) will act as a collaborative planning group for Mental Health services within the Glenrothes and North East Fife Community Health Partnership.

Composition

Membership will be drawn from Glenrothes and North East Fife Community Health Partnership, Mental Health Directorate, partner agencies, local voluntary organisations and service users and carers as follow:-

Meetings

- The group will meet every second month
- Agenda and working papers will be circulated not less than five working days before each meeting.
- Minutes will be prepared by administrator for LMHP and will be approved at the next meeting of the group.

Remit

The remit of the LMHP is to:

- Promote integration of statutory and voluntary agencies working across boundaries to meet the Mental Health agenda
- Shape and inform mental health strategy at a Fife-wide level and agree on the delivery of strategy at a local level
- Monitor mental health targets.
- Monitor the health and well-being agenda to allow local evaluation of the effectiveness of local mental health services
- Identify local mental health needs and priorities for development
- Incorporate key roles and funding of the Area Redesign Teams
- Engage with the public, non statutory and statutory organisations to publicise the work of the LMHP

Reporting Arrangements

The LMHP is expected to:

- Report to Glenrothes and North East Fife CHP in relation to mental health targets within the CHP Delivery Plan
- Report to the Mental Health SIG in relation to supporting the implementation of Delivering for Mental Health
- Bring to the attention of the Mental Health SIG, any issues within Glenrothes and North East Fife which require a Fife-wide approach or prioritisation

Members are expected to:-

- Participate fully in all aspects of business associated with the LMHP
- Report to their respective statutory and non-statutory organisations on the work of the LMHP
- Advise and inform LMHP of the views of non-statutory organisations
