- Be familiar with Fife Multi-Agency Adult Protection Guidance, know what harm is and be able to identify the indicators of harm
- Understand the requirement to share information to protect adults at risk of harm
- Understand individual and multi-agency responsibilities in Adult Protection and the legal duty to co-operate under the Adult Support and Protection (Scotland) Act 2007

Course attendees will have previously undertaken some single agency training, and should be in a role that involves multi-agency working.
